Varland has been flying for more than 20 years, has a bachelor's degree in aviation management. He has instructed part 61/141 and flown professionally under parts 91, 91k and 135. In 2014 he was hired into the Will Rogers Flight Standards District Office as an Aviation Safety Inspector. As an ASI he had oversight of commercial operators working under parts 133, 135, 137 and 141 as well as providing medical flight reviews, 44709's and check rides. In June of 2017, Aaron joined the Federal Aviation Administration Safety Team (FAASTeam). In his position on the FAASTeam Aaron has spent the last 5 years studying what causes incidents and accidents in the state of Oklahoma and uses that information to help pilots fly more safely.

Mike Grimes said that he and Susie just celebrated their 51st anniversary and her birthday. She was on TV for an interview about the Friends of the Library book sales that they have the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of each month. It is at 510 Elm in Yukon.

Our speaker, Lt. Col. McCullum from the Civil Air Patrol (CAP) informed us that CAP predates the US Airforce. It started in 1941 and the Airforce in 1947. They recently celebrated their 75th anniversary in OPA member Tony Plant's hangar. He noted that there was a CAP poster shown in the credits of the Captain America movie. They helped the US Army in WWII by carrying weapons, etc. where they were needed.

Some of their duties include looking for planes that are missing and doing search and rescue flights. They were credited with saving 60 lives in '23. They also do disaster relief including sending visual images to FEMA to help them allocate resources. They were chartered by the US Congress and funded by grants from Congress. CAP Cadets can get their pilots certificate fully funded by the government. Every CAP member, whether young or old, must have basic knowledge of aerospace. We enjoyed a lot of interesting information about CAP, including the fact that Oklahoma has a group of 800 unpaid professionals who serve our state. Twin brothers received their SPOTS award from a Thunderbird pilot who was a former CAP member.
